

Back To School & Daycare During COVID-19

To ensure your child care provider is following best practices and guidelines set forth by the CDC and state authorities, we recommend asking the following questions before re-enrolling your child:

What are the screening procedures for your facility?

- Are they offering non-contact temperature checks?
- Are all staff, students, and parents being screened?
- Are the drop off schedules staggered?
- Are they requiring one parent to pick up or drop off your child?

How are they practicing physical distancing strategies?

- Is the seating 6 feet apart in all directions?
- Are playground times staggered?

What prevention strategies are being used?

- Is the school promoting hand washing?
- Are face coverings required for everyone over the age of 2?
- Is the staff being trained?

What will meal time look like?

- Is food being served and eaten in the classroom away from other kids?
- Will each child have their own plate?
- Will the kids be kept apart during mealtime?

How will my child's classroom be cleaned?

- Will all toys and personal items be disinfected, and how often?
- Will the entire classroom be disinfected each night?

What is the school's plan if the teacher or student is sick?

- Is there a number to contact?
- What is the process for school closures?
